The gunroom has heated lockers and a warm space to swap stories after the day.






















SOUTHESK ESTATE

Kinnaird Castle, Brechin, Angus Pheasant Shooting

Kinnaird Castle lies at the heart of the Southesk Estate between the towns of Brechin and Montrose in the county of Angus, north of Dundee and is inland from the Montrose Basin.

The Shoot

Guests shoot over 10,000 acres of estate and farmland with the focus around Kinnaird Castle and the Park. The Park is surrounded by estate walls and completely private with minimal travelling between drives. The parkland terrain suits a wide variety of shooting abilities from the complete beginner to the competent shot.

A Typical Day

The day would start at around 9 am with the guns meeting at Kinnaird Castle. Tea or coffee and a bacon roll will be served in the Ante Hall where you will meet the HeadKeeper, David Harris, who will give you a quick briefing for the day. Full elevenses will be provided with lunch served in the Castle around 1pm. Drinks are included with lunch. Tea and coffee are available on a self-service basis after the end of the shoot in the gun room.
